Gentlemen:

The Rocky River Municipal Court herewith submits its 21st Annual Report for the year ending December 31, 1978 in compliance with Ohio Revised Code 1901.14.

The contents of this report are based upon data assembled and tabulated by Ben K. Wright, Clerk of Courts and his staff. Although this report is detailed with respect to statistics for political subdivisions within the Court jurisdiction, the following are noteworthy facts and figures;

- (1) The total funds received from all sources in 1978 amounted to \$759,192.47, which represents an increase of \$68,754.24 over 1977.
- (2) The total number of criminal cases filed in 1978 was 15,719 an increase of 1,488 over 1977.
- (3) The amount of funds dispersed to the City of Rocky River in 1978 from all sources was \$334,976.35 an increase of \$43,179.77 over 1977.

Although there was an increase in criminal cases filed, the Rocky River Municipal Court was able to maintain one of the most current trial dockets in the State of Ohio. The Rocky River Municipal Court also has the distinction of having a current civil docket. This recognition is accorded to both Judge Milton D. Holmes and Judge William J. McCrone for their diligence and devotion to duty.

A special acknowledgement for loyal and dedicated service is extended to Kathleen Walsh and Ethel Hartle. Mrs. Walsh and Mrs. Hartle retired December 31, 1978, after many years of conscientious service as Deputy Clerks with the Rocky River Municipal Court. They will truly be missed; but certainly not forgotten.

I extend my sincere appreciation to the entire Court Staff for their devotion to our judicial system's effectiveness. I also take this opportunity to thank Mayor Earl Martin, the Rocky River City Council and all the Officials of the Rocky River Municipal Court District for their help and co-operation which has been extended to this Court.
