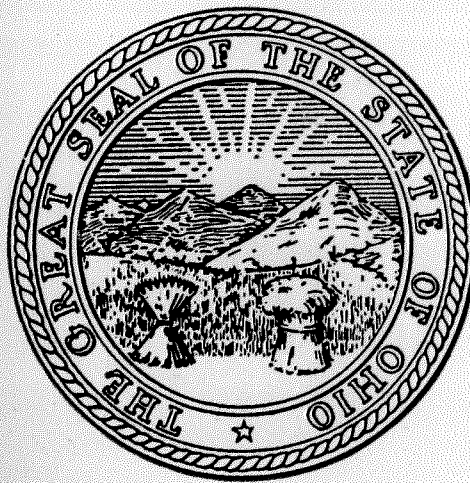

Gentlemen:

The Rocky River Municipal Court herewith submits its 22nd Annual Report for the year ending December 31, 1979 in compliance with Ohio Revised Code 1901.14.

The contents of this report are based upon data assembled and tabulated by Ben K. Wright, Clerk of Courts and his staff. Although this report is detailed with respect to statistics for political subdivisions within the Court jurisdiction, the following are noteworthy facts and figures;


- (1) The total funds received from all sources in 1979 amounted to \$781,661.81, which represents an increase of \$22,469.34 over 1978.
- (2) The total number of criminal cases filed in 1979 was 15,612.
- (3) The amount of funds dispersed to the City of Rocky River in 1979 from all sources was \$323,323.39.

In addition to the above, the Rocky River Municipal Court was able to dispose of 1,660 civil cases and 659 small claim cases.

As always, the Rocky River Municipal Court has been able to maintain one of the most current trial dockets in the State of Ohio. The credit for such a fine record is extended to Judge Milton D. Holmes and Judge William J. McCrone.

I also take this opportunity to thank the entire Court Staff for their diligence and devotion to duty, to Mayor Earl Martin, the Rocky River City Council and all the Officials of the Court District for their help and co-operation which has been extended to this Court.
