To the Council of The City of Rocky River and The Board of County Commissioners of Cuyahoga County

Gentlemen:

The Rocky River Municipal Court herewith submits its 24th Annual Report for the year ending December 31, 1981, in compliance with Ohio Revised Code 1901.14.

The contents of this report are based upon data assembled and tabulated by Ben K. Wright, Clerk of Courts and his staff. Although this report is detailed with respect to statistics for political subdivisions within the Court jurisdiction, the following are noteworthy facts and figures;

The total funds received from all sources in 1981 amounted to \$975,872.23, an increase of \$255,246.19 over funds received in 1980.

The total number of criminal cases filed in 1981 was 17,119,

an increase of 4,945 cases filed in 1980.

The amount of Court costs dispersed to the City of Rocky River in 1981 from all sources was \$346,522.35, an amount exceeding the costs of operating the Rocky River Municipal Court by \$52.085.73.

In addition to the above, the Rocky River Municipal Court disposed of 2,325 civil cases and 802 small claim cases.

As always, I extend my deepest gratitude to the entire Court staff for their diligence and devotion in making the Rocky River Municipal Court one of the finest Municipal Courts in the State of Ohio. I also extend my thanks to Mayor Earl Martin, The Rocky River Council and all the Officials of the Court District for their help and co-operation which they have given this Court.
