To the Council of the City of Rocky River and the Board of County Commissioners of Cuyahoga County

Gentlemen:

The Rocky River Municipal Court herewith submits its 25th Annual Report for the year ending December 31, 1982, in compliance with Ohio Revised Code 1901.14.

The detailed contents of this report represent voluminous data assembled and tabulated by the Court staff. Although the report is designed to provide statistics for the seven political subdivisions which comprise the Court's jurisdiction, the following noteworthy facts and figures represent a few of the Court's collective activities:

- (1) The total funds received from all sources in 1982 amounted to \$1,215,620.18, an increase of \$239,747.95 over funds received in 1981.
- (2) The total number of criminal cases filed in 1982 was 16,789, a decrease of 1,180.
- (3) The amount of Court costs dispersed to the City of Rocky River in 1982 from all sources was \$397,971.19, an amount exceeding the costs of operating the Rocky River Municipal Court by \$45,696.05.

Of further note are the 2,054 civil and 799 small claims cases the Rocky River Municipal Court disposed of during Fiscal Year 1982.

I wish to extend my sincere thanks to the entire Court staff for their diligence and devotion which have made the Rocky River Municipal Court one of the finest Courts in Ohio. Many thanks also to Mayor Earl Martin, the Rocky River Council and all the Officials of the Court District for their continued help and support.
