Pursuant to Section 1901.12(D) of the Ohio Revised Code, the Rocky River Municipal Court herewith submits its 26th Annual Report for the year 1983.

The contents of this report are based upon data assembled and tabulated by Ben K. Wright, Clerk of Courts, and his staff. Although this report is detailed with respect to statistics for political subdivisions within the Court's seven jurisdictions, the following are note-worthy reflections:

(1) The total funds received from all sources in 1983 amounted to \$1,136,147.46.

(2) The total number of criminal cases filed in 1983 was 12,795.

(3) The amount of Court costs dispersed to the City of Rocky River in 1983 from all sources was \$286,277.42.

The Rocky River Municipal Court disposed of 1,848 civil cases and 823 small claim cases during the fiscal year of 1983.

I extend my deepest thanks to the entire Court staff for their diligence and devotion which have made the Rocky River Municipal Court one of the finest Courts in our State.

Sincere appreciations are also extended to Mayor Earl Martin, the Rocky River City Council, the Police Officers and Officials of the Court District for their continued help and support.
