

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Section 1901.12(D) of the Ohio Revised Code, the Rocky River Municipal Court herewith submits its 27th Annual Report for the year 1984. *1180*

The contents of this report are based upon data assembled and tabulated by Ben K. Wright, Clerk of Courts, and his staff. Although this report is detailed with respect to statistics for political subdivisions within the Court's seven jurisdictions, the following are note-worthy reflections:

- (1) The total funds received from all sources in 1984 amounted to \$1,117,021.54. *1,110,334.85*
- (2) The total number of criminal cases filed in 1984 was 14,817. *14,851*
- (3) The amount of Court costs dispersed to the City of Rocky River in 1984 from all sources was \$381,925.84. *580,000.00*

In addition to the above, the Court disposed of 13,037 criminal cases, *1734* 2041 civil cases and 728 small claims cases. *1002*

As always, the credit for a great effort goes to our excellent Court Staff, the Prosecutors for the various jurisdictions and of course to Judge Milton D. Holmes and Judge William J. McCrone.

Sincere appreciations are also extended to Mayor Earl Martin, the Rocky River City Council, the Police Officers and Officials of the Court District for their continued help and support.
