Pursuant to Section 1901.12 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Rocky River Municipal Court herewith submits its 29th Annual Report for the Year 1986.

The contents of this report are based upon data assembled and tabulated by Ben K. Wright, Clerk of Courts and his Staff. Although this report is detailed with respect to statistics for political sub-divisions within the Court's Jurisdiction, the following are note worthy reflections:

- (1) The total funds received from all sources for the year 1986 amounted to \$1,219,716.40.
- (2) The total number of criminal cases filed in 1986 were 14,930.
- (3) The amount of Court Costs dispersed to the City of Rocky River in 1986 from all sources amounted to \$504,533.28.

As always, the credit for a great effort goes to our excellent Court Staff, the Prosecutors for the various jurisdicitons and of course to Judge Milton D. Holmes and Judge William J. McCrone.
