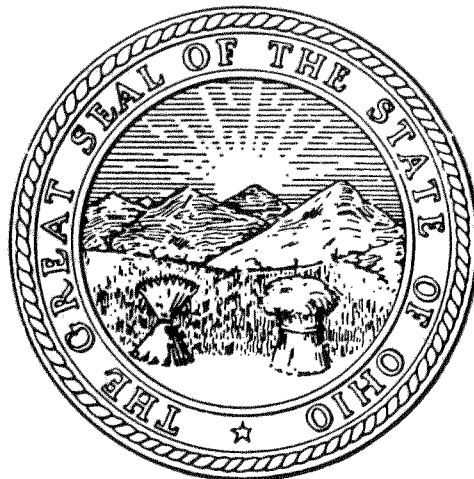

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Section 1901.12 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Rocky River Municipal Court herewith submits its 30th Annual Report for the Year 1987.

The contents of this report are based upon data assembled and tabulated by Ben K. Wright, Clerk of Courts and his Staff. Although this report is detailed with respect to statistics for political sub-divisions with the Court's Jurisdiction, the following are note worthy reflections:

- (1) The total funds received from all sources for the year 1987 amounted to \$ 1,308,908.33.
- (2) The total number of criminal cases filed in 1987 were 15,679.
- (3) The amount of Court Cost dispersed to the City of Rocky River in 1987 from all sources amounted to \$553,093.84, an increase of \$48,560.56 over 1986.

As always, the credit for a great effort goes to our excellent Court Staff, the Prosecutors for the various jurisdictions and of course to Judge Milton D. Holmes and Judge William J. McCrone.

On November 11, 1987, Judge William J. McCrone passed away. Judge McCrone was elected as Judge of the Rocky River Municipal Court in 1971 when the Court qualified for two Judges. He was re-elected unopposed in 1977 and again in 1983.

Judge McCrone will be dearly missed by the Staff of the Rocky River Municipal Court. He was fun-loving and hard working. He was a man concerned about people who were poor and extended a hand to those in need. He was a Scholar of Law who was always striving for perfection. He was the recipient of eighteen awards from the Ohio Supreme Court for Superior Judicial Service which is the highest award the Supreme Court bestows upon Trial Judges. We bid you farwell Judge McCrone, we will hold you in our hearts.

Sincere appreciations are extended to Mayor Earl Martin, the Rocky River City Council and Police Officers and Officials of the Court District for their continued help and support.
