To the Cuyahoga County Commissioners, Mayors, City Council Members and Police Chiefs of the Cities of Rocky River, Fairview Park, Westlake, North Olmsted, and Bay Village

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Section 1901.12 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Rocky River Municipal Court

herewith submits its 31st Annual Report for the Year 1988.

The contents of this report are based upon data assembled and tabulated by Ben K. Wright, Clerk of Courts and his Staff. Although this report is detailed with respect to statistics for political subdivisions within the Court's Jurisdiction, the following are noteworthy reflections:

(1) The total funds received from all sources in the Year 1988 amounted to \$1,483.869.93 an increase of \$174,961.60 over 1987.

(2) The total amount of criminal cases filed in 1988 were 15,388. The statistical breakdown includes: 12,655 traffic, 769 DUI/BAC, 1647 misdemeanors and 317 felonies.

(3) In 1988, an increase of civil case filings in the Rocky River Municipal Court's Civil Division generated additional Court costs collected by \$17,272.76 from the previous year.

(4) The total amount of Court costs dispersed to the City of Rocky River in 1988 from all sources amounted to \$609,674.33 an increase of \$56,580.49 over 1987.

In May 1987, the Court began implementation of computerizing the Criminal Branch of the Court. On January 1, 1988 the computerization of the Civil Branch was implemented. At the present time the Court is 95% computerized. The software programs were developed by the Courts' own Staff which saved the Court thousands of dollars. It should be noted that many Courts in the State of Ohio are now using the software programs developed with the assistance of the Rocky River Municipal Court Staff.

On January 1, 1988, Maureen A. Gravens was appointed Judge by the Governor of Ohio to fulfill the unexpired term of Judge William J. McCrone who passed away November 11, 1987.

The Court welcomes Judge Gravens and wishes her the best in her new position.

The Rocky River Municipal Court has been recognized for many years as having one of the most current dockets in the State of Ohio. This accomplishment is the reflection of the diligent and unselfish service of Judge Milton D. Holmes and the dedicated performance of an excellent Court Staff.

Sincere appreciations are extended to Mayor Earl Martin, the Rocky River Council and Police Officers and Officials of the Court District for their continued help and support
