Dear Ladies and Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Section 1901.12 of the Ohio Revised Code, The Rocky River Municipal Court herewith submits it's Thirty-Third Annual Report for the Year 1990.

The contents of this report are based on data assembled and tabulated by Ben K. Wright, Clerk of Courts and his Staff. Although this report is detailed with respect to statistics for political subdivisions within the court's jurisdiction, the following are noteworthy reflections:

- (1) The total funds received from all sources in the year 1990 amounted to \$1,873,915.20 an increase of \$257,919.32 over 1989.
- (2) The total number of Traffic/Criminal cases filed in 1990 were 17,714. The statistical breakdown includes: 14,298 traffic, 1,356 DUI/BAC, 1,714 misdemeanors and 345 felonies which is an increase of 749 over 1989.
- (3) In 1990 Civil case filings in the Rocky River Municipal Court's Civil Division was 1,701 and total Civil court costs collected was \$100,001.79.
- (4) The total amount of court costs disbursed to the City of Rocky River in 1990 from all sources amounted to \$703,390.79 an increase of \$26,756.67 over 1989.

1990 was a year of considerable change in the Rocky River Municipal Court. The court experienced a significant increase in the number of cases filed in previous years. An attempt to meet the demands of the increased workload by improving the court operation and facilities was initiated. These innovations will promote greater efficiency and productivity by eliminating delay, unnecessary expense and all other impediments to the expeditious administration of justice.

One of the changes implimented was the appointment of Michael D. Mitchell to the position of Traffic Referee/Magistrate. Mr. Mitchell's 17 years as Small Claims Referee has been one of unquestionable devotion. His professionalism and jurisprudence in reconciling complicated disputes between small claim litigants are respected by those who utilize the Small Claims Division of the court. Mr. Mitchell's additional responsibilities will give both Judge Milton D. Holmes and Judge Maureen Gravens much needed time for trial adjudication.

In May 1990, Thomas Marsh was appointed Bailiff for Judge Milton D. Holmes. Tom retired as Chief from the North Olmsted Police Department after 27 years of distinguished service. At the age of 51, Tom's knowledge in the field of law enforcement administration and procedures has complimented the Rocky River Municipal Court's high standards. Working with Chief Thomas Marsh is a pleasure for everyone associated with the court system.

Another extremely qualified individual added to the staff at the Rocky River Municipal Court was Mary Kay Schabel as Probation Officer. Mrs. Schabel was appointed Probation Officer in February 1990. She received her degree from Bowling Green State University in 1978. She majored in Criminal Justice and minored in Psychology, graduating Cum Laude. After completing her formal education at Bowling Green, Mary Kay served for 10 years as Probation Officer with the Cuyahoga County Common Pleas Court. She received her state certification as an alcohol counselor in 1986.

Mrs. Schabel's duties at the Rocky River Municipal Court include presentence investigation, alcohol assessments and supervision of probationers. Mrs. Schabel's expertise in alcohol and drug rehabilitation is highly recognized in the West Shore communities. The Rocky River Municipal Court is very privileged in having Mrs. Schabel on the staff.

I also want to take this opportunity to thank the entire staff of the Rocky River Municipal Court for their outstanding and dedicated work. They have all accepted the change and improvements at the court and at the same time have had to work hard to maintain a continuously current docket. The entire staff of the Rocky River Municipal Court is an asset to the communities in our court district.

As always, sincere gratitude is extended to the City of Rocky River's Mayor, Earl Martin, The Rocky River Council, Police Officers and officials of the Rocky River Court District for their continued assistance.
