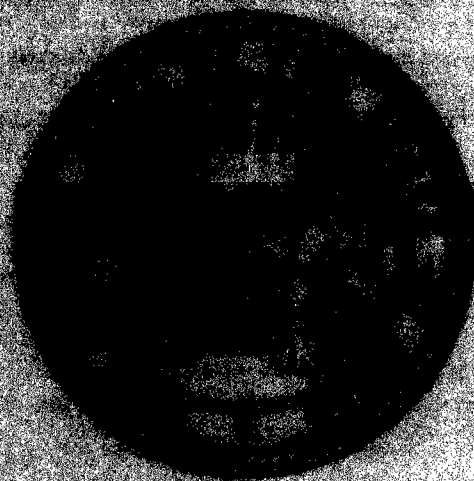

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen:

*Pursuant to Section 1901.12 of the Ohio Revised Code, The Rocky River
Municipal Court herewith submits it's Thirty-fifth annual report for the Year 1992.*

*The contents of this report are based on data assembled and tabulated by Ben
K. Wright, Clerk of Courts and his Staff. Although this report is detailed with
respect to statistics for political subdivisions within the court's jurisdiction,
the following are noteworthy reflections:*

- (1) The total funds received from all sources in the year
1992 amounted to \$2,264,209.88 an increase of
\$278,634.59 over 1991.*
- (2) The total number of Traffic/Criminal cases filed in 1992 were 20,244.
The statistical breakdown includes: 15,414 traffic, 1508 DUI/BAC,
1850 misdemeanors and 470 felonies which is an increase of 1,002
over 1991.*
- (3) The 1992 Civil case filings in the Rocky River Municipal Court's Civil
Division was 1758 and total Civil court costs collected was \$297,722.20.*
- (4) The total amount of court costs disbursed to the City of Rocky River in
1992 from all sources amounted to \$941,259.13 an increase of \$123,666.91
over 1991.*

The year 1992 was a very busy year for the Rocky River Municipal Court. The year was also a milestone in the history of the Court. Judge Milton D. Holmes retired June 30, 1992, Patrick A. Gareau, the first Prosecutor of the Court, died June 3, 1992 and William C. Huffman was appointed Judge on August 24, 1992 replacing Judge Holmes.

Milton D. Holmes was appointed Judge of the Rocky River Municipal Court in February 1961 by Governor Michael V. DiSalle to fulfill the unexpired term of Judge Robert Frost who was elected to the Cuyahoga County Common Pleas Court bench. Judge Holmes described by many as a "brilliant legal scholar", served the court for 31 years.

Judge Holmes always wanted to be a lawyer, but getting into the legal profession wasn't easy. He was born with glaucoma and had lost most of his sight by the time he entered law school. As a Western Reserve University law student, Holmes struggled to read texts with his limited sight, but with the assistance of a few good friends, Holmes graduated as a member of "Order of the Coif" (an acknowledgement to students who graduate in the top ten percent of their class) and also received the Throckmorton Award for Constitutional Laws.

A colleague who admired Holmes' research ability convinced him to set up a partnership in Cleveland after graduation. Holmes acquiesced and in 1951 he became solicitor of Newburgh Heights where a petition he drafted was used as a model in an appellate law book.

In 1959, Holmes was Assistant Attorney General of the State of Ohio. He taught at Cleveland Marshall Law School and Cleveland State Law School.

Holmes, a Civil War buff and past president of the Cleveland Civil War Roundtable, is a voracious reader of American history. He listens to at least three recorded books a week on many subjects and has near total recall of something read aloud to him.

Judge Holmes has enjoyed his judicial career in law and his peers give him high marks as a student and scholar. During his tenure at the Rocky River Municipal Court, he's received 14 awards from the Supreme Court of Ohio for Superior Judicial Service. We are indeed grateful to Judge Holmes for his years of dedicated service to our court, dedication to the law, and his keen sense of humor. He will be extremely missed but certainly not forgotten.

Before becoming a lawyer, Patrick A. Gareau graduated from John Carroll University with a degree in accounting. He worked as a detective in the homicide and burglary units of the Cleveland Police Department for seven years. In 1954 he was assigned to assist Bay Village police in the investigation of the death of Marilyn Sheppard, whose murder received nationwide publicity. While working as a detective, Gareau graduated from Western Reserve University with a degree in law.

In 1957 Pat was appointed a federal law clerk and served a term as safety director in the City of North Olmsted.

A practicing trial attorney for 34 years, Mr. Gareau served as Rocky River Municipal Court district prosecutor for 10 years. He also served as Westlake's Law director for 22 years and Strongsville's Law director for 23 years.

Pat Gareau loved his work and was admired and respected by his friends and colleagues. He was a gentle family man, an idealist who had the interest of justice and fairplay at heart. He will be deeply missed by the court and others whose lives he gently touched.

Judge William C. Huffman, Presiding and Administrative Judge of the Rocky River Municipal Court was appointed to the bench September 1992 by Governor George V. Voinovich to fill the unexpired term of Judge Milton D. Holmes.

Admitted to the Ohio Bar in 1980, Judge Huffman had been in the private practice of law with his father Mr. Charles Huffman, Jr. of Westlake, until his appointment to the bench of the Rocky River Court. He is also licensed to practice law in the state of Florida. A graduate of the College of Wooster, Judge Huffman received his law degree from Case Western Reserve University.

A life-long resident of the West Shore area, Judge Huffman was a Westlake City Councilman until his judicial appointment. He also served as a member of the Westlake Planning Commission and president of the Lakewood Civil Service Commission until 1985. He is involved in many civic activities and looks forward to seeking retention on the bench of the Rocky River Municipal Court.

Thomas A. Marsh, bailiff for Judge Holmes retired from the Court in June 1992. Thom previously retired as Chief of the North Olmsted Police Department after 27 years of distinguished service. At age 51, he brought to our court a wealth of knowledge in the field of law enforcement administration. Thom was respected for his skills and easy going manner. Working with Chief Marsh was a pleasure for everyone associated with the court system.

Thom's position as bailiff was filled by Alice T. Cater of North Olmsted, Alice is a graduate of Vista Maria Academy located in Warren, Michigan. She attended Notre Dame College in South Euclid, Ohio for 2 years.


