Dear Ladies and Gentlemen:

As required by Section 1901.14 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Rocky River Municipal Court herewith submits it's Annual Report for 1999.

The contents of this Report are based on data assembled and tabulated by William E. Gareau, Clerk of Court, and his staff. The following data are noteworthy for the year 1999.

- 1. The total funds received from all sources in the year 1999 amounted to \$4,346,271.86, an increase of \$624,197.29 over 1998.
- 2. The total number of criminal/traffic cases filed in 1999 was 22,976. The statistical breakdown includes 19,328 traffic, 731 DUI/BAC, 2,472 misdemeanors and 445 felonies. The total criminal/traffic case filings were up 5,560 cases over 1998.
- 3. The civil/small claims case filings in 1999 were 1,848. The statistical breakdown includes 1,136 civil cases and 712 small claims cases. The total civil/small claims case filings were down 293 cases from 1998.
- 4. The total amount of court costs disbursed to the City of Rocky River in 1999 from all sources amounted to \$2,249,034.03 an increase of \$487,189.13 over 1998. Of these funds, \$263,757.00 was placed in a special Computer Fund set up by the Court on January 1, 1996, which are not available for use in operational costs. In addition \$268,025.00 was placed in a Special Projects Fund established by the Court on January 1, 1999. These funds could only be used for the purpose of providing a new Court facility.

During 1999, the Rocky River Municipal Court finally converted over to a new computer system. Though we had problems converting data, we are confident the new system will serve the Court in the future. The most pressing need now is for the Court to move into a facility that can accommodate both the Judges' and the Clerk's staffs. Rocky River City Council and Mayor Umerley have initiated steps in 1999 to make this possible.

I want to thank the entire staff of the Clerk's Office for their hard work and dedication. I would also like to thank Presiding/Administrative Judge Donna Congeni Fitzsimmons, Judge Maureen Adler Gravens and their staffs for their help and guidance during the year.

Finally, great appreciation is extended to Rocky River Mayor Don Umerley, Rocky River City Council, Police Officers, and Officials of the Rocky River Court District for their assistance.






