To the Cuyahoga County Commissioners, Mayors, City Council Members and Police Chiefs of the Cities of Rocky River, Bay Village, Fairview Park, North Olmsted, and Westlake, and Metroparks

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen:

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As required by Section 1901.14 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Rocky River Municipal Court herewith submits its Annual Report for 2001. The contents of this report are based on data assembled and tabulated by William E. Gareau, Clerk of Court, and his staff. The following data are noteworthy for the year 2001.

- 1. The total funds received from all sources in the year 2001 amounted to \$5,996,947.31, an increase of \$892,600.01 over 2000.
- 2. The total number of criminal/traffic cases filed in 2001 was 35,735. The statistical breakdown includes 31,433 traffic, 822 DUI/BAC, 2578 misdemeanors, 433 felonies and 469 parking violations. The total criminal/traffic case filings were up 1,830 cases over 2000.
- 3. The civil/small claims case filings for 2001 were 2,149. The statistical breakdown includes 1,264 civil cases and 883 small claims cases. The total civil/small claims case filings were up 20 cases over 2000.
- 4. The total amount of court costs disbursed to the City of Rocky River in 2001 from all sources amounted to \$2,914,047.15 an increase of \$407,304.14 over 2000. Of these funds, \$415,485.00 was placed in a special computer fund set up by the Court on January 1, 1996, which are not available for use in operational costs. In addition, \$417,178.00 was placed in a Special Project Fund established by the Court on January 1, 1999. These funds will be used to provide a new Court facility.

Most notable is the continuing increase in case filings over the past seven years. We had an increase in total filings from 36,034 in 2000 to 37,884 in 2001. Since 1995 we have gone from 16,735 to 37,884 cases, a 126% increase in 7 years. This increase is due to implementation of traffic enforcement programs to cut down on injury accidents within various cities throughout the court district.

During the year 2001, the City of Rocky River continued the process of providing a new Court facility for the Rocky River Municipal Court. It is anticipated that construction will be completed by January 2003. The building will be located at the site of the old Rocky River Memorial Hall. We acknowledge the effort of the late Mayor Don Umerley for his persistence and dedication in fulfilling his plan to modernize the entire city hall campus including the Court.

I want to thank the entire staff of the Clerk's Office for their hard work and dedication especially Chief Deputy Clerk Deborah Comery who was given responsibility for compiling this report. I would also like to thank Presiding/Administrative Judge Donna Congeni Fitzsimmons, Judge Maureen Adler Gravens and their staffs for their help and guidance during the year. Finally, appreciation is extended to Rocky River Mayor William Knoble, Rocky River City Council, Police Officers, and Officials of the Rocky River Court District for their assistance.
