

To the Cuyahoga County Commissioners, Mayors, City Council Members and Police Chiefs of the Cities of Rocky River, Bay Village, Fairview Park, North Olmsted, and Westlake, and Metroparks

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen:

As required by §1901.14 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Rocky River Municipal Court herewith submits its Annual Report for 2006. The contents of this report are based on data assembled and tabulated by William E. Gareau, Clerk of Court, and his staff. The following data are noteworthy for the year 2006.

- 1. The total funds received from all sources in the year 2006 amounted to \$5,847,243.26 a decrease of \$984,826.20 from 2005.
- 2. The total number of criminal/traffic cases filed in 2006 was 25,536. The statistical breakdown includes 21,745 traffic, 614 DUI/BAC, 2,471 misdemeanors, 385 felonies and 321 parking violations. The total criminal/traffic case filings were down 7,289 cases from 2005.
- 3. The civil/small claims case filings for 2006 were 2,887. The statistical breakdown includes 2,173 civil, 712 small claims and 2 rent escrow/trusteeship cases. The total civil case filings were up 185 cases over 2005.
- 4. The total amount of court costs disbursed to the City of Rocky River in 2006 from all sources amounted to \$2,565,665.04 a decrease of \$181,217.63 from 2005. Of these funds, \$319,406.00 was placed in a special computer fund set up by the Court on January 1, 1996. In addition, \$319,024.13 was placed in a Special Project Fund established by the Court on January 1, 1999. The money in these funds will be used to enhance the Courts computer system and pay off the debt of the new court building. Also, \$93,661.50 was placed in the Courts probation services fund. The monies in these special funds are not available for operational costs.

The court experienced a 22.2% decrease in criminal/traffic cases and a 7% increase in civil cases during 2006. Civil cases have risen for the past six years. The court has no control over the number of criminal/traffic or civil cases filed each year.

The courts website www.rrcourt.net continues to grow. E-Payments, Public Records Access, Local Rules, Jury Service information, Probation information and current court costs are among the many items found on our website. Links to other agencies and services are also available. Since the fourth quarter of 2003 the website has processed over 1.5 million dollars in fines and costs for over 12,000 cases. The official record for all 2006 cases is computerized and available on the website.

I want to thank the staff of the Clerk's Office for their hard work and dedication during the year. Special thanks are given to Chief Deputy Clerk Deborah Comery who was given responsibility for compiling this report. I would also like to thank Presiding/Administrative Judge Maureen Adler Gravens and Judge Donna Congeni Fitzsimmons, and their staffs for their help and guidance during the year. Finally, appreciation is extended to Rocky River Mayors William Knoble and Pamela Bobst, Rocky River City Council, Police Officers, and Officials of the Rocky River Court District for their assistance.

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



MISSION STATEMENT:

The Probation Department is a division of Rocky River Municipal Court dedicated to monitoring and rehabilitating offenders of misdemeanor and traffic laws sentenced through the Rocky River Municipal Court system. Our goal is to protect the public and closely monitor these probationers while they are under community control in an attempt to prevent them from re-offending in the future.
