Dear Ladies and Gentlemen:

This Annual Report, covering 2007, chronicles the last year of service of William E. Gareau as Clerk of Court. Bill provided the Court with 12 years of leadership and progress, making RRMC one of the finest courts in the State of Ohio. My best wishes to Bill for a relaxing, yet fun-filled retirement. As we begin 2008, the Court welcomes Judge Brian F. Hagan. We look forward to this new era and extend our support as Judge Hagen begins his term of service as a Judge of the Rocky River Municipal Court.

As required by §1901.14 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Rocky River Municipal Court herewith submits its Annual Report for 2007. The contents of this report are based on data assembled and tabulated by Deborah F. Comery, Clerk of Court, and Court staff. The following data are noteworthy for the year 2007.

- 1. The total funds received from all sources in 2007 amounted to \$5,648,848.02 (a decrease of \$198,395.24 from 2006) of which \$1,801,245.35 was earmarked for Operational Expenses. Since 1997, this Court has operated with its income.
- 2. The total number of criminal/traffic cases filed in 2007 was 24,778. The statistical breakdown includes 20,909 traffic, 682 OVI/BAC, 2,379 misdemeanors, 427 felonies and 381 parking violations. The total criminal/traffic case filings were down 758 cases from 2006.
- 3. The civil/small claims case filings for 2007 were 3,208. The statistical breakdown includes 2,327 civil, 872 small claims and 9 rent escrow/trusteeship cases. The total civil case filings were up 321 cases over 2006.
- 4. The total amount of court costs disbursed to the City of Rocky River in 2007 from all sources was \$2,769,240.49, an increase of \$203,576.45 over 2006. Of these funds, \$301,060.50 was placed in a special Computer Fund set up by the Court on January 1, 1996. In addition, \$543,410.21 was placed in a Special Project Fund established by the Court on January 1, 1999. These funds are used to enhance the Court's computer system and continue to pay off the building debt of the Courthouse (occupied in 2003). Also, \$109,214.74 was placed in the Court's Probation Services Fund and \$15,810.00 was placed in the Court's Mediation Fund. The monies in these special funds are not available for basic operational costs.

The court experienced a 2.9% decrease in criminal/traffic cases and a 11.1% increase in civil cases during 2007. Civil cases have risen for the past seven years. The court has no control over the number of criminal/traffic or civil cases filed each year.

The Court's website, www.rrcourt.net, continues to grow. E-Payments, Public Records Access, weekly Court Dockets, Local Rules, Jury Service information, Probation information, Annual Reports, and current court costs are among the many items found on our website. Since 2003, the website has accepted ePayments primarily for those defendants who are allowed to waive their traffic ticket. 2007 saw 5,619 transactions, up 6% from 2006. All Court documents, for both current and historical cases, continue to be imaged and are available on the website. In 2008, the Court will add E-Filing to its many website services.

I want to thank the staff of the Clerk's Office for their hard work and dedication during the year. I would also like to thank Presiding/Administrative Judge Donna Congeni Fitzsimmons and Judge Maureen Adler Gravens, along with their staffs for their help and guidance during the year. Grateful appreciation is also extended to Rocky River Mayor Pamela E. Bobst, Rocky River City Council, and all the Jurisdictional Police Officers and Officials of the Rocky River Court District for their assistance.






